Pre-Convention Tour-Hester House

(Friday afternoon, 5:45 p.m.-6:45 p.m.): One of the beautiful Philadelphia historical homes that was built by Nathan Cramer, Jr. has been reserved for Mu State Kappas to tour. The original stained glass windows are located in the wraparound gallery. The house has been occupied by only two families, the Hester and the Hitt family. Bobbie Hitt and her husband are the current owners.



Post-Convention Tour: <u>Williams Brothers General Store</u>

(Saturday afternoon, following convention): Here's something that you won't find anywhere else still in operation. It is a true old-fashioned store founded in 1907 by brothers Amazie and Brown Williams which is now in the hands of second and third generation Williamses. The store has served farm and city population continuously through changing times. In 1939, National Geographic featured it as a "needles to horse collars" store. Today,

groceries, shoes, clothing, Peter's pottery, and farm needs such as fence posts, seed, grain are in the inventory. On any Saturday afternoon, two men slice bacon and cut off hunks of hoop-cheese for 10 hours a day. The crowds would make Walmart blush. Archie Manning's wife, Olivia, is the daughter of one of the founders. It has been told that Peyton and Eli had summer jobs during their earlier years. They may still visit now and then, but they've found better jobs (word has it:)! The state theme of "Live, Love, Laugh for Kappa-Everlasting Friendships" will be shared among us at State Convention! Please reserve your hotel room at Dancing Rabbit Inn (601-389-1044) no later than <u>Friday, April 5th.</u> To receive group rate of \$79 (plus tax), you will need to state DGKKI as your reservation code when making hotel reservation. After April 5th, the room rates go up to \$129 plus tax. (Please note that a \$50 refundable security deposit is required at time of check-in like many hotels require. It will be refunded upon check-out within 72 business hours on your credit card.) Hotel has an indoor swimming pool, fitness center, and guests receive a free continental breakfast.
