CALL TO STATE CONVENTION

This is your <u>official call</u> to the Mu State Kappa State Convention to be held on April 29-30, 2016, in Columbus, MS, "the Friendly City " at the Courtyard by Marriott (1995 6th Street North). With its rich historical heritage, it is the perfect destination for the Mu State Kappa Kappa lota 55th State Convention with the theme being "Paint Mu State with Kappa Love." Much has been planned by our hosting chapter, Beta, for Mu State Kappas to have a Grand Time.

Known for Columbus's Spring Pilgrimage, a <u>Pre-Convention tour</u> (*Friday after-noon, April 29th from 5:30 p.m. to 6:45 p.m.*) has been planned to tour the **WhiteHall Antebellum Mansion.**



Built in 1843 by James Walton Harris, Whitehall was originally designed as a two-story Greek Revival townhouse. The stately mansion exhibits six square, paneled columns at the edge of a wooden porch. The banisters bordering the porch consist of identically-milled hardwood balusters. Inside the home, heart-pine floors and handsome woodwork provide the background for the Boggess' collection of eighteenth- and nineteenth-century antiques.

Dr. and Mrs. Joe Boggess & Family are the current owners with Whitehall being listed on the National Register/Historic American Buildings.

<u>Post Convention Tour (continued):</u> Old Waverly Golf Club, one of the South's premier golf destinations has become the home of the Mississippi State University's men's & women's varsity golf programs, a \$2.5 million project with private fundraising through the Bulldog Club.



Not only have Pre and Post Convention Tours been planned for this year's State Convention, but for the April 29th,

Friday night "Welcome Reception," you will hear more details on the MSU Varsity Golf Center, and an inspiring message from MSU Women's golf coach, Ginger Brown-Lemm. In her tenure, Coach Lemm has already accomplished what no other coach in the state of Mississippi has ever done by leading her team to three-straight NCAA Tournaments, including back-to-back championship appearances in 2013 and 2014.

The Friday night "Welcome Reception" will also include Italian cuisine with surprises.

For **Saturday, April 30th,** our keynote speaker will be Jasmine Murray, Miss Mississippi 2014, who was also a finalist in the eighth season of the American Idol. The highlight to conclude the day will be the election and installation of the 2016-2017 Mu State Officers. Our Mu State Kappas will also honor our Kappa sisters in our Celebration of Life service for those who have joined our Omega Chapter with Beta member, Diann Carter, presiding over this service.
