#### From Booneville:

-Take MS 4 to Ripley -Turn left at the intersection of MS 4 and MS 15 -Follow MS 15 to enter Blue Mountain 5 miles South of Ripley -College Entrance in on the right -Ray Dining Hall is at the top of the hill on the right

#### From Tupelo:

-If coming in on I-22 West/US 72 W, take exit 64 to MS 15 North -Continue North on MS 15 to enter Blue Mountain 16 miles North of New Albany -College Entrance in on the right -Ray Dining Hall is at the top of the hill on the right

#### From Jackson (via I-55):

-Drive North on I-55 N to Batesville -Take Exit 243A toward Oxford -From MS-6 E, take the MS-7 exit for Water Valley/Holly Springs -Exit MS-7 to MS-30 E toward New Albany -Continue to New Albany -Take the I-22/US-78 -Take exit 64 for MS-15/MS-30 E toward Pontotoc/Ripley -Turn left onto MS-15/MS-30 E -Continue North on MS 15 to enter Blue Mountain 16 miles North of New Albany -College Entrance in on the right -Ray Dining Hall is at the top of the hill on the right Directions to The Peoples

-At the intersection of MS 15 and MS 4 in Ripley, go north -Drive approximately 425 feet -Operations Center is on the left
