National Convention Highlights (Continued)

Members were able to attend three business meetings, the annual Memorial Service, and several workshops. Optional tours included Biltmore House and Gardens, DuPont Forest Waterfalls and Cradle of Forestry Tour, Crest Mountain Dinner and Show, Historic Downtown Asheville, Lake Lure Pontoon Boat Ride, a Blue Ridge Parkway Tour, and a post- convention tour of western North Carolina. Notable reports were:

- There were 20,605 total empathy contacts reported for the 2016-2017 year.
- The National Philanthropic Report showed 1,325,903.95 total monies or monetary value donated with 1,606,58.25 total hours volunteered.
- Moise Jones and Patsy Johnson were presented the Incentive Award for recruitment of new and/or reinstated members during the 2016-2017 year.
- Imogene Hardon, Jerrie Jackson, and Moise Jones received the V.I.P. Award for excelling in Kappa leadership.
- History books were on display from seven states: MS, OK, GA, OH, TN, NC, and FL.







Katie Draper, 2016-2017 Mu State President, represented Mississippi proudly in the flag ceremony and as a "Wingette". Joyce Graddy, Anita Mills, and Mitzy Johnson-Mills contributed their vocal talents to the Kappa Choir.
